- Must be able to attend trainings;
- Report to all scheduled shifts and meetings in a punctual and professional manner;
- Notify the EA in advance if unable to attend shift or complete responsibilities;

Dress Code: Casual

Job Descriptions: The food bank is the head of Food Services for Emergency Social Services under the RMWB Emergency Management. In this role we supply people to ensure evacuation/lodging reception sites for people affected by Emergency situations i.e. fires, floods etc... have access to food at these sites. Volunteering on this committee could mean you never get called out or you could get called out a lot depends on what is going on in the region.

Requirements:

- Assist in running food station at reception centers
- Assist in setting up food services at reception site
- Assist in obtaining kit from food bank
- Assist in food planning
- Attend trainings as possible/available

- Strong communications and interpersonal skills;

- Work with limited supervision;
