TO ENTER: Complete your team information below and return this form. Entrants are responsible for purchasing or collecting all canned goods used for their structure. Tax receipts are available from the Wood Buffalo Food Bank when Food Purchase Receipts are provided.

ENTRY FEE: To secure your commitment to enter the competition, there is a \$200 non-refundable fee, which will cover the set-up of each Build Area on Build Day, including pre-ordered "crowd-control" ropes. Entry Fee due upon entry submission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: Sculpture size must not exceed 10'L x 10'W x 8' H. No limit on team size, but only five builders at any one time are allowed in the designated build area. Sculptures concepts must follow the Theme of **"Canada 150"** and a description or rendering must be submitted for theme matching no later than June 2, 2017.

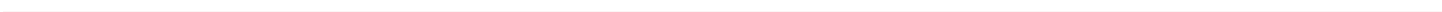

OVERVIEW: RULES AND REGULATIONS FORT MCMURRAY COMPETITION

STRUCTURES:

- Maximum size for structures are 10'L x 10'W x 8'H.
- Cans must be full, unopened, and with labels intact and legible.
- Labels may not be covered, stripped off or altered in any way.
- Structures must be structurally self-supporting.
- **What building materials are NOT permitted?**
 - 2 x 4's;
 - half-inch plywood or thick tubing;
 - sheet metal;
 - glass containers;
 - pet food;
 - alcoholic beverages; and
 - Permanent adhesives.
- **What building materials are permissible?**
 - aluminum food cans of all sizes;
 - one-quarter inch thick foam-core; cardboard, Masonite, plywood, Plexiglas;
 - threaded rod (for the purpose of leveling or; balancing materials and not as load bearing);
 - cardboard tubes used as guides must be limited to one-quarter inch thick;
 - Velcro; clear and double-faced tape; High-tension rubber bands, nylon string, wire, tie-backs, and magnets.

AQUISITION OF CANNED GOODS:

- Competing teams are responsible for obtaining their own supply of canned goods.
- Competing teams may secure sponsorship to assist them with food acquisition.
- Save On Foods is our partnering Grocery Store and a 15% discount will be applied to all Canstruction® Purchases. Order Deadline will be **June 1, 2017 (tentative)**. All Food Will be delivered to MacDonald Island no later than **June 28, 2017**.

TEAM ENTRY:

- Deadline for Entry: **April 28, 2017**.
- Each team must submit a description of their structure and a Team Roster by **June 15, 2017**.
- Maximum size of the official team is unlimited; however, only 5 people may work within the build site at any given time.
- Team Captains must attend the group team captain meeting or schedule an individual meeting with us prior to **June 15, 2017**.

BUILD DAY:

- Build day may be scheduled for any 12hrs between **June 28 and June 30, 2017**.
- Each team must meet with Canstruction® Coordinator prior to starting to build.
- Although 3 days are given, each team's build may only take 12 hours total.

JUDGING:

- Judging will commence on the morning of **July 1, 2017**.
- Competition decisions are left in the hands of the Jury.

AWARDS:

- 6 Awards will be given in the following categories:
 - Best Meal;
 - Best Use of Labels;
 - Structural Ingenuity;
 - People's Choice;
 - Juror's Favorite; and
 - Honorable Mention.
- Local winners go on to compete internationally through submission of digital photography.

AWARDS CEREMONY:

- TBD – **July 1, 2017**.

DE-CANSTRUCTION:

- **July 2, 2017**.
- Each entry must be taken down and placed in holding area for pick-up by Food Bank;
- De-Canstruction® arrangements must be made through the Canstruction® coordinator with the food bank when making Canstruction® schedule.
